07 Tell someone one kind thing that is true.

08 Give someone quiet space when they need it.

09 Take turns choosing a story.

10 Put away a toy so it is ready to share.

11 Cheer for someone who is trying something hard.

12 Use a gentle voice during a busy moment.

16 Thank a grown-up who reads with you.

17 Be patient while someone learns a new skill.

18 Make room for someone beside you.

19 Listen to an idea that is different from yours.

20 Ask before borrowing, and return it with care.

21 Say, 'Would you like help?' and respect the answer.

22 Tell someone you know what you appreciate about them.

23 Choose a kind word to say to yourself.

24 Repeat a kindness that made your day brighter.

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
